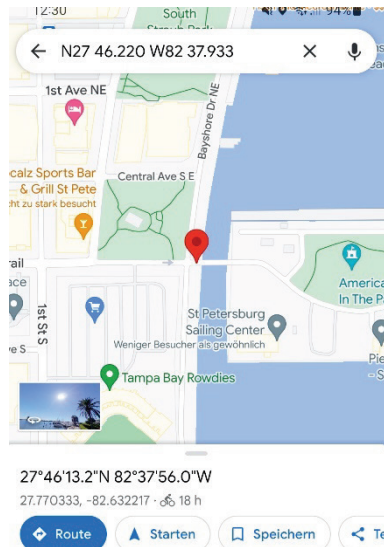
Note on location: In Central Florida, most cities merge, it's difficult to tell where they start and where they end. That's why I apologize if I've mistaken a place.

hhdd°mm.mmm specified. The degree character is replaced by space, the first 0 omitted.

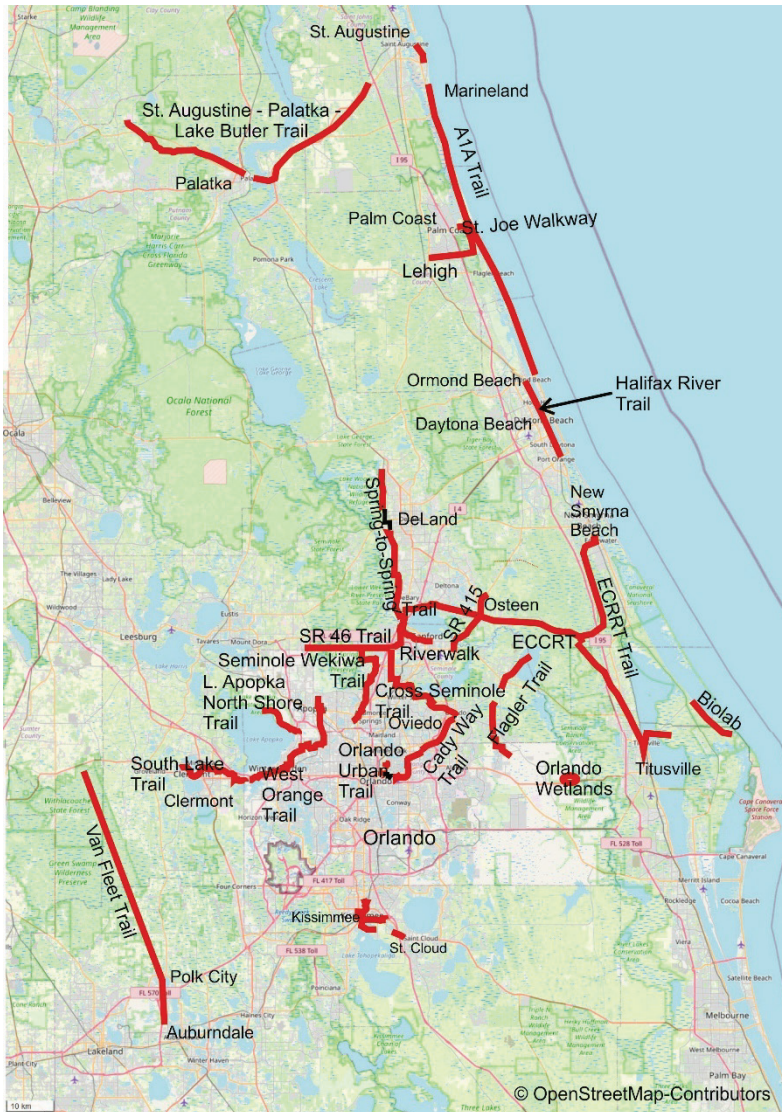
Know how to navigate with the GPS points?
