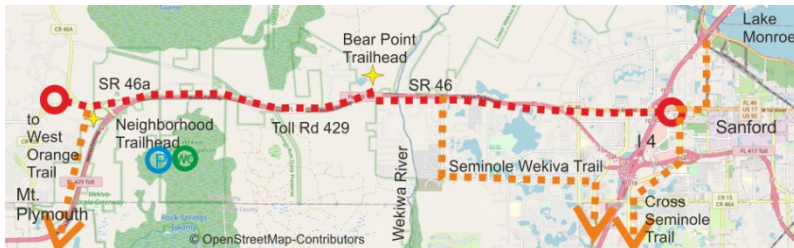


Seminole County – Trails

2. Sanford – Mt. Plymouth (Wekiva Trail) along SR 46, 12 mi (19 km)

This new trail runs along SR 46, it is safely separated from the road, but noisy and open and can be very hot. The first part from Sanford is not marked as a bike trail. From the Lake county line at Wekiva river the trail is marked and named. This trail is important, because it connects to 3 main trails in Central Florida.



M 0.0 Corner of SR 46 / I 4 eastern limit of Sanford, N28 52.039 W81 18.670.

M 4.3 At Longwood Markham Rd we cross the start of the Seminole Wekiva Trail.

M 5.2 At Wekiva River county line between Seminole and Lake County, **mile marker 0.0 for the Wekiva Trail**, N28 48.896 W81 25.165. Shortly after we change to the other side of SR 46, there is **Florida Trail Bear Pond Trailhead**. Not much parking.

M 11 Neighborhood Lakes Trailhead, N28 48.765 W81 30.764. Mile marker of Wekiva Trail 6.0. Large parking and picnic tables, Porta Potty. From here is a connection to the West Orange Trail, see page 83 (end).



M 11.7 End of trail at Hojin St near Mt. Plymouth, N28 48.758 W81 31.417. Mile marker of Wekiva Trail 6.5.
