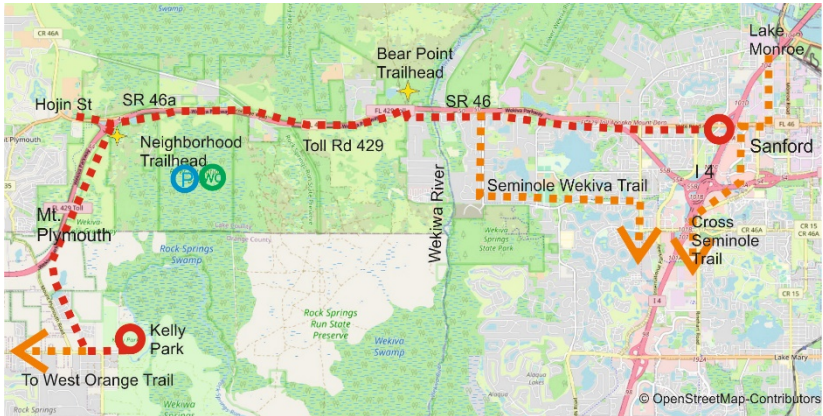


Seminole County – Trails

2. Sanford – Mt. Plymouth (Wekiva Trail along SR 46) – Kelly Park, 16.5 mi

This new trail runs along SR 46, it is safely separated from the road, but noisy and open and can be very hot. The first part from Sanford is not marked as a bike trail. This trail is important, because it connects to 3 mayor trails in Central Florida.



Although the trail ends in Neighborhood Lakes Park, I recommend ride on the road until Kelly Park (2.7 mi), because this park is very beautiful, perfect for swimming.

Start: Sanford City Limit (I 4)	N28 48.669 W81 20.357

Mi 0 Corner of SR 46 / I 4 western limit of Sanford, N28 48.669 W81 20.357. Trail on southern side of SR 46.

Mi 4.1 At Longwood Markham Rd we cross the start of the original Seminole Wekiva Trail, N28 48.869 W81 24.349. Now they call the new trail along SR 46 also Wekiva Trail, and the official start is at the county line.

Mi 5 At Wekiva River County line between Seminole and Lake County, **mile marker 0.0 for the Wekiva Trail**, N28 48.896 W81 25.165. Shortly after we change to the other side of SR 46, there is **Florida Trail Bear Pond Trailhead**. Not much parking.

Seminole County – Trails

Mi 10.8 Neighborhood Lakes Trailhead, N28 48.765 W81 30.764. Mile marker of Wekiva Trail 6.0. Large parking and picnic tables, restrooms.

If you continue straight on this trail you reach after 0.7 mi end of trail at Hojin St, N28 48.758 W81 31.417. Mile marker of Wekiva Trail 6.5. Will be continued in the future to Mount Dora.



But to continue to Kelly Park follow the trail inside Neighbor Lake Trailhead.

Mi 13.8 West Gate of the park, end of trail. Ride along Mt. Plymouth Rd to the south, no shoulder.

Mi 15.5 Kelly Park Rd, turn left. **Mi 16** Intersection with Rock Springs Rd., continue straight. **Mi 16.5 Kelly Park**, N28 45.505 W81 30.270, fee 1 \$ per bicycle.

Connection to West Orange Trail

From the intersection of Rock Springs Rd follow this road 3.7 mi on bike lane or side walk, later trail, to Welch Rd, northern start of West Orange Trail, N28 42.342 W81 30.542. Stay on east side of the road.
